## 2010 Umpire News and Notes

### UMPIRE REGISTRATION

- **HOW TO REGISTER** – Umpires can register in person at the Metro Omaha Softball office at 1606 S. 50<sup>th</sup> St. or by mail. ALL REGISTRATION MATERIAL IS ALSO AVAILABLE—AND CAN BE DOWNLOADED—on our WEBSITE. Regardless, please make sure to thoroughly complete the registration form.
- **REGISTRATION DEADLINE** – **For all returning umpires (those who worked league play in 2009) is March 13. There will be a \$5.00 late fee if you register after that time. New umpires or umpires moving in from out of town may register at any time without a late fee.**
- **UMPIRE UPDATES ON THE "WEB"** – All other umpire information will be available on our website, [www.metroomahasoftball.com](http://www.metroomahasoftball.com). We will also update the website as needed throughout the season.

### REGISTRATION FEES

Since all Metro Omaha Softball leagues in 2009 will again follow the ASA rulebook (with a few minor exceptions), your base registration fee includes a registration with The ASA. **Metro Omaha Softball and ASA fee for 2010: \$90. Make all checks payable to Metro Omaha Softball LLC**

### CLINIC SCHEDULE FOR 2010 – All Day Session at Crown Plaza Hotel on March 13

Our annual all-day clinic has been changed this year. There will be a Part A & Part B. ALL umpires will be required to attend Part A. MOS umpires with 3 years or less experience will be required to attend BOTH Part A & B. The Clinic will be in the Regency Ballroom. Crown Plaza Hotel is located at 655 North 108<sup>th</sup> Ave.

**Registration-8:30-9:00am Part A(All Umpires) 9:00am-12:30pm Lunch-1 Hour(on your own)**

**Part B 1:30-4:30pm(New Umpires and Umpires with 3 or less years experience)**

**Follow Up Clinics** – Umpires unable to attend the March 13 clinic MUST attend the two (2) indoor clinics that will be held at the **Ultimate Baseball Academy**, 4225 S. 121st Plaza (one block west, then one block north of the intersection at 120<sup>th</sup> & I). Meeting room on 2<sup>nd</sup> level. All sessions will be 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. Those dates are:

- Tuesday March 16—Session A
- Thursday March 18—Session B

### ***OUTDOOR "MECHANICS" CLINICS***

Umpires with three (3) or less years of experience will be required to attend two of the outside clinics. All other umpires will be required to attend one (1) session. **Umpires are required to be in Uniform for the outdoor clinics.**

Again, we have provided plenty of time for you to arrange your schedule to attend the required clinics. If you are unable to attend any of the scheduled clinics, you will NOT be scheduled for the first six (6) weeks of the season. You will be allowed to work as a replacement umpire.

Outdoor clinics – If there is inclement weather, call the MOS weather line—991-4026.

## Umpire Schedules and Assignments

- League schedules for Metro Omaha Softball umpires will be completed by Bob Hawkinson in conjunction with the Softball Office.
- **If you need to "cancel out" of a game assignment Monday-Friday, contact the softball office. DO NOT, REPEAT, DO NOT, FIND YOUR OWN REPLACEMENT.** You should do everything possible to give 24 hours notice that you will not be able to work your assigned games. You are aware that it is very, very difficult to find replacement umpires when you make a same day cancellation. **ONLY ON WEEKENDS, WHEN THE BUSINESS OFFICE IS CLOSED, WILL YOU BE EXPECTED TO FIND YOUR OWN REPLACEMENT. This rule does not apply, however, to tournament assignments made by Metro Omaha Softball.**
- **Again IN 2010 –** Metro Omaha Softball will NOT assign you to work more than 5 games in one day
- **Again IN 2010 CONCERNING WEEKEND ASSIGNMENTS– IF YOU WORK A TOURNAMENT DURING THE DAY ON SUNDAY, THEN DO NOT WORK SUNDAY NIGHT LEAGUE PLAY.**
- **New in 2010- Umpires that cancel game assignments after 4:00pm the same day more than 2 times will be fined \$10 for each additional canceled assignment after 4:00pm. Payment is due within 5 business days or the remainder of your schedule will be pulled until payment is received.**

## Missing Assignments or Working Solo – IMPORTANT MESSAGE

- In 2009, there continued to be many missed assignments without notice. We understand emergencies occur and unavoidable conflicts happen at the last minute. However, the Softball Office should be notified in some manner. **In 2010, the following rules will be enforced with regard for missed assignments without notification and Finding Your Own Replacements Monday-Friday:**

- **1<sup>st</sup> occurrence – Probation for the rest of the season**
- **2<sup>nd</sup> occurrence – One month suspension**
- **3<sup>rd</sup> occurrence – Suspension for the season**

- Working "solo" – a) If you are assigned a partner and he/she does not show, the office must be contacted; b) If you are late for your assignment and the first inning has been completed, DO NOT expect to be paid if you go on the field to work.

## A Guide to Canceling Games in Progress Due to Lightning and/or Rain

The weather is the single most unpredictable factor affecting any softball season. Metro Omaha Softball umpires will use the following criteria for canceling games in progress as taken from Appendix D of the NCAA rule book and as recommended by the National Severe Storms Laboratory (NSSL):

*"Thunder always accompanies lightning, even though its audible range can be diminished because of background noise ... The current recommendation of the NSSL is to consider terminating play when the lightning is six miles away ("flash-to-bang" time of 30 seconds or less). This ... was developed as a practical way to make a judgment in situations where other resources ... are not available."*

## Umpire Pay on Games Called Due to Rain or Other Threatening Weather

If thee (3) complete innings OR one-half the time limit have been completed, the umpire is entitled to keep the game fees. If the umpire works less than three (3) complete innings OR less than one half of the time limit, the game fees will be returned. In this situation, IF both teams involved agree to re-schedule the game, umpires will be paid a full game fee.

## REMINDER FOR 2010!! – Complete the Test!

**In 2010, NO umpire will be scheduled to work games until they have completed the Metro Omaha Softball Rules Test. This test MUST be turned in to the office—either in person or by mail OR FAX—by April 1. The test will include questions concerning ASA rules and MOS league play. You must achieve a score of 80 per cent or better to receive assignments. If you do not achieve a score of 80 percent, you will be allowed to re-take the test one time. If you still do not achieve an 80 percent score, you will not assigned any games and will receive a refund of your registration fee.**

### ACCEPTABLE SHORTS IN 2010

The ONLY acceptable style of shorts (for slow and fast pitch play) will be a "coaches' " type short or any polyester-material short with belt loops. "Basketball style" nylon/silk fabric shorts, "cargo style" shorts OR pants with side pockets; "Bermuda style" shorts; blue denim shorts/pants of any type/style ARE UNACCEPTABLE.

### NOTES ON UNIFORM FOR 2010:

- 1) IF WE OBSERVE YOU WORKING A GAME AND WEARING ANY CLOTHING THAT DOES NOT MEET OUR UNIFORM STANDARDS, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE PARK.**  
 The following rules will be enforced with regard for being out of UNIFORM.

- 1<sup>st</sup> occurrence – Probation
- 2<sup>nd</sup> occurrence – One month suspension
- 3<sup>rd</sup> occurrence – Suspension for the season

- 2) During particularly cold weather, stocking caps, gloves and other clothing may be used to keep warm. Just look as "official" as possible. **HOWEVER, DO NOT WEAR A LONG SLEEVE SHIRT UNDER YOUR SHORT UMPIRE SHIRT. Wear a jacket instead.**
